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

Academic Excellence



How do we achieve excellence?

- STREAM (Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Art, and Math) Program for all students in grades 2 through 8.
- Leveling in Math, Language Arts, and Spanish as well as High School level courses in Spanish and Math for 7th & 8th grade students.
- Bilingual Spanish Program through Boston College for all students.

- Successful implementation of daily real-time virtual teaching which enables mastery of gradelevel standards.
- Tech-enabled learning through an iPad program, computers and smart boards in every classroom.
- Professional staff development covering all subject areas, faith formation, instructional strategies, and child development.
- Academic recognition in local, state and national competitions.





Well Rounded Students

St. Agnes Academy is committed to the cognitive, physical, spiritual, and emotional development of our students to mold them into well-rounded adults.

How do we prepare good stewards and leaders?

- School sports for boys and girls including cross-country, basketball, soccer, flag football, and volleyball.
- After-school enrichment classes including chess, science, robotics, and engineering.
- Schoolwide and grade specific stewardship programs that encourage students and their families to share their gifts and talents.

- Student leadership opportunities through Student Council, National Junior Honor Society, yearbook staff, Reading Buddy Initiative and Safety Patrol Program.
- Leadership recognition through awards such as Good Citizen and Good Neighbor.



Safe & Healthy **Environment**

St. Agnes Academy provides students with a safe and healthy learning environment in which to grow academically, spiritually, physically, and emotionally.

How do we safeguard our students and surroundings?

- A closed campus with a state-ofthe-art security system, highly trained faculty and staff, a security guard and Key Biscayne Police Department resource officer • A recycling program which on campus, and police support during student drop-off and pickup times.
- A comprehensive socioemotional counseling program which includes classroom guidance, individual counseling, conflict resolution, an Empower Me Program, and a zero tolerance to bullying policy.
- Facilities for physical activity and sports including basketball courts, a fully-equipped playground, a

- large sports field and a soon to be built state of the art gymnasium/ multipurpose room.
- encourages the school community to "Reduce, Reuse, & Recycle" and a "Walk to School Wednesdays" initiative to foster environmentally conscious students.
- Education in cyber literacy for students and strict guidelines and policies regarding the safe and responsible use of information and communication technology.





Community Engagement
